Please be aware of a few structural changes for this year's camps. All camps will run from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM, and each camper will need to bring their own lunch.

Camps that do not require potty training will be clearly noted in the index and in each camp description. If a camp does not state this, it assumes your child is potty-trained, meaning they no longer wear pull-ups and can recognize when they need the restroom, tell an adult, and use it independently at home and beyond the home.

BUMC SUMMER CAMP/VBS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Please keep in mind that while we will do everything reasonable to keep your children and our staff healthy, BUMC Children's Ministry summer programs are not a 100% risk free environment. The responsibility lies with each individual person and family to maintain a healthy environment for children by following our camp policies and those of local authorities.

1. Only staff and students are permitted in the building once camps have started. Parents are not permitted unless there is a specific need to be there and arrangements are made in advance.
2. All Camp/VBS drop-offs and pick-ups will be at the camp door. Parents/caregivers will bring children into the building and sign students in and out each day at the camp door.
3. If your child has experienced any of the following symptoms in the last 24 hours, they will not be permitted to attend camp:
 - Feeling feverish or temperature above 100*
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Cough
 - Difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - Diarrhea
 - Nausea
4. Anyone picking up a child must be listed at the time of registration as an approved/authorized pickup. Authorized people picking up children should have ID available if they are not readily recognizable to the staff or director.
5. Lunches, snacks, and water bottles need to be provided from home.
6. Hands will be washed before and after snack time as well as throughout each camp activity. Hand sanitizer will be available in every room.
7. If a child should become ill during camp/VBS, we will care for that child until a parent/caregiver can pick the child up. The ill child will be removed from camp and comfortably monitored in a separate area near the front office. Parents should have plans in place to pick up an ill child within 30 minutes of notification.
